Old Sturbridge Village (OSV) is the largest outdoor history museum in the Northeast focused around telling the story of rural New England in the 1830s. The village proper spans more than 200 scenic acres and encompasses more than 40 original buildings, a district school, working farm, water-powered mills and more. The mission of Old Sturbridge Village is to invite guests to explore, interact, engage, and learn from living history.

The town of Sturbridge is home to restaurants, breweries, retail shops, entertainment, as well as many hotels and lodges that offer overnight accommodations. OSV realizes the responsibility of being a community anchor and the importance to bring visitation beyond the gates of the village, to the entire Sturbridge community.

OSV has received a grant from the Sturbridge Tourism Association to assist in this effort which is in addition to the financial commitment OSV is making to implement a strong, cohesive Group Tour Sales and Marketing program.

Group Tour Sales – what it is and how it works

A travel company which buys individual travel components, separately from their suppliers and combines them into a package tour, which is sold with their own price tag to the end consumer is called a Tour Operator. The relationship with the tour operator and the suppliers they work with is a business to business (B2B) relationship. The Tour Operator makes a profit by creating an itinerary and bundling attractions, restaurants and accommodations which they sell as a package to their customers. These groups typically travel by bus otherwise known as a motorcoach.

The motorcoach, travel and tourism industry play an important role in our society. It creates jobs, provides access for rural communities, and contributes to environmental sustainability. For these reasons and others, the industry continues to see significant, year-to-year passenger growth and ridership.

The goal of the Group Tour Sales and Marketing program is to target Tour Operators who bring motorcoaches in and around New England for day trips and multi day trips and present OSV and the entire community of Sturbridge as a destination.
