Rust on Bathroom Fixtures

Hair in the Refrigerator

Heavily Stained and Soiled Carpets

Stains in the Bathtub

Unsanitary Conditions

Phone covered in black grime

LC-JR, when you returned for a re-inspection were all the violations rectified?

JR-No, somethings had been addressed but not all.

JT- What are each of your roles in the Hotel?

RU-It is not my responsibility to oversee housekeeping.

AK-I am not in the building every day. I have started a log of maintenance items and RU or I will always be on property.

LC-When the Health Inspector comes out multiple times to re-inspect one property it costs our department extra money and takes time away from everyday inspections.

JR-Carpet and detailed cleaning are the main problems at the property.

AK-The main issue with the carpeting is on the 1st floor. My absence from the property has been contributing to the problems facing the hotel. Moving forward we have these items planned to fix/finish by year end:

Finish Pool

Professional carpets cleaning on 40 rooms

Hire a Head Housekeeper

Switch out the Hotels lock system

JT-If changes aren't made the Board could make you hire a company to train your staff, suspend your license to operate, or impose fines upon you.

LC- The Board recommends you hire a company to train staff on proper cleaning procedures. We also recommend you hire a company to come in a thoroughly clean the property from top to bottom. The Health Inspector will come back in one month for a re-inspection.
