# Survey Results

As was discussed at the last business breakfast this past June, the Town conducted a survey of businesses and asked that they participate in a SWOT analysis of the Town. It should be noted that while the Town did receive a number of survey responses as well as input at the breakfast, there was not enough surveys to make them a statistically significant sample of all Town businesses. However it does provide us with a good snapshot of those businesses who participated and those who were present at the Business Breakfast. After compiling all of the results there were a few takeaways, all of which have been provided to the Board of Selectmen, Town Staff and the appropriate local Boards and Committees.

- 1. Businesses see Local Boards and Committees as challenging
- 2. Sturbridge benefits greatly from its location
- 3. There is potential for greater collaboration amongst businesses
- 4. Roadways, parking and blight in Town present a great challenge to development
- 5. There is potential for local economic growth by attracting more anchor businesses (e.g. Sports Complex)
- 6. Town Staff are a strength in our community

From these survey results, I have proposed two courses of action for the Town to take:

- 1. Continue its outreach efforts to the business community, such as through its tours program, the business classes, the breakfasts, etc.
- 2. Form a focus group, made up of a diverse group of business owners representing all business sectors in Town. This group will focus on answering three questions:
  - a. What are the current challenges for businesses in Sturbridge as it relates to local Town government?
  - b. What are the short and long term solutions for each of the challenges identified?
  - c. How should the Town evolve to become business friendly to all businesses in Sturbridge?

The findings of this group will then be shared with the Board of Selectmen and other Boards and Committees that interact with the business community. We are in the early discussions regarding next steps. We will provide more information shortly.

#### New Town Website


The Town of Sturbridge has recently developed a newly redesigned Town Website. The new site is designed for ease of

to any potential investors. It is our goal to see all of these properties filled with businesses that support the diversity of the Sturbridge economy.
