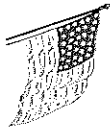

## WIT RUDY JULIAN

the honor of Platoon Sargent Joseph R. presented, posthumously the MEDAL OF Honor for his service at Iwo Jima. The citation, reads, in part; "For conspicuous gallantry and valor and beyond the call of duty . . . in action during the seizure of Iwo Jima in the Volcano on Sargent Julian quickly established his own, initiative fearlessly moved forward in the nearest pillbox. Advancing alone, he and white phosphorus grenades into the trench the remaining five into nearby trenches. He moved into the trench and despatched the five enemy . . . Intent on wiping out all resistance, he attacked and knocked out two more cave positions and launched a bazooka attack unassisted, remaining pillbox and completely destroying it by a vicious burst of enemy fire . . . His spirit of self-sacrifice throughout the bitter the highest traditions of the United States we his life for his country". signed; Harry Purbridge Veteran to receive the MEDAL OF Honor we dedicate this monument to him,



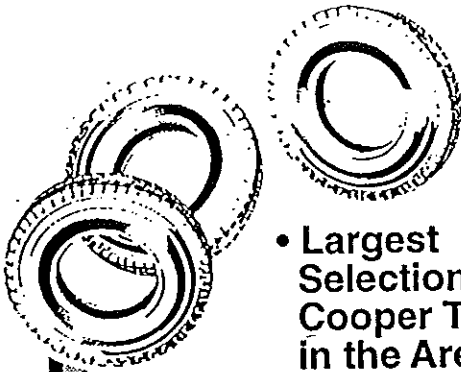
