Town of Sturbridge Skating Rink Rules

- Skating rink is weather permitting, open dawn to dusk. You must obey the OPEN/CLOSED sign
- Face coverings are required for visitors of parks and open spaces in accordance with COVID-19 Order 55: Revised Order Requiring Face Coverings in Public Places, to prevent against the transmission of Covid-19. Face coverings must be worn by all participants during active play and skating
- Maximum of <u>six</u> people on the ice rink at one time. Please be mindful of others and rotate ice usage in 1 hour (maximum) increments
- Ice Hockey allowed during the following designated times **only**: Sunday 9:00-11:00 AM for individual skill work only. NO pick-up games or organized practice. Ice hockey is a high-risk sport
- No food, drink or gum chewing while skating
- Do not sit on the side boards
- No one on ice without skates
- No bikes, skate boards, motorized scooters or dogs allowed on the ice
- For your child's safety we recommend children wear helmets
- Please keep the rink tidy! Please put your litter in the trash cans
- All children 16 and under <u>must</u> have adult supervision
- Skate with the flow, no racing or dodging other skaters
- After visiting public spaces, users should wash their hands or use hand sanitizer
