

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


# National Flood Hazard Layer FIRMette

## Re: Notice of Intent Project Narrative Proposed Residential House Reconstruction 168 Lane 7, Sturbridge, MA CMG ID 2023-137

Dear Members of the Commission,

On behalf of Stephen and Valerie Quink (Applicant), CMG is writing this letter to provide a summary of the proposed site improvements to be located at 168 Lane 7 in Sturbridge, MA ("the Site"). The Applicant is proposing to demolish the existing single-family structure and reconstruct the house within approximately the same footprint of the existing structure. Hardscapes associated with patios and walkway located behind the existing house are also proposed to be reconstructed in place.

The approximately 1.6-acre Site, identified as assessor parcel 391-00148-168 is located in the Rural Residential (RR) Zoning District. The Site is located on the shores of Quacumquasit Pond. The upper limit of the pond was delineated by Ecotec, Inc. on September 18, 2017. A FEMA Flood Zone AE associated with the pond is also located on-site. The existing structure is serviced by a private drinking water well and an on-site septic system.

A Notice of Intent (NOI) was filed for this site in 2017 which was ultimately approved by the Sturbridge Conservation Commission under DEP File #300-1004. The Order of Conditions (OOC) called for removal of trees and renovation of the existing stone/concrete stairs located behind the house (which leads to the pond). The applicant completed the tree removal but did not commence work associated with the hardscape improvements. A COC for the completed tree work is being submitted with this NOI application.

The applicant is proposing to demolish the existing three (3) bedroom house and reconstruct, in relatively the same footprint, a new three (3) bedroom house. A slight expansion of the footprint is proposed along the northern side of the existing structure. A garage-under is proposed along the front of the dwelling which will require a slight expansion of the gravel driveway and also a retaining wall. The applicant intends to include the previously approved hardscape improvements in this NOI. Equipment access to the existing stone/concrete walk will be achievable with the demolition of the existing house. Erosion control straw wattles are proposed along the limits of the delineated wetlands. Two proposed material staging/ stockpile areas are also proposed in areas located outside of the 100' jurisdictional buffer.

The proposed work falls within the 100' jurisdictional buffer and the 200' local bylaw jurisdictional buffer. As a result, the applicant is submitting a Notice of Intent with the Sturbridge Conservation Commission in

order to allow the proposed site improvements. Further details associated with the improvements are shown on the enclosed site plan entitled, "Notice of Intent Plan - #168 Lane 7, Sturbridge, MA", prepared by CMG, dated July 20, 2023.
