A.6. General Project Description Site: 530 Leadmine Road, Sturbridge Applicant: Sandra Bacon

The applicant proposes to construct a 1,248 square foot replication area for a 1,200 square foot stable wetland crossing constructed in 1995. The original plan by Green Hill Engineering, dated 10/22/1996 showed a 1,125 square foot replication area for 975 square feet of wetland loss. Special condition #16 on the Order of Conditions, dated 6/28/1995, called for 1:1 replication. The new Green Hill Engineering plan, dated 5/5/2023, contains EBT, Inc's details on how the replication area is to be constructed and who will be overseeing the construction of the replication area.

The new proposed replication area is further east than the original replication, as EBT, Inc saw both hydric soils and a predominance of wetland vegetation where the original replication area was shown - EBT, Inc's wetland line vary from the 1994 wetland lines. Mr. Farrell performed an as built of the crossing in 2022 showing an increase in wetland loss in relation to Mr. Farrell's original wetland lines (the width of the crossing is slightly wider than proposed). EBT, Inc delineated up to the boulder retaining wall wetland crossing but did not continue at the toe of the slope of the crossing on the north or south side of the driveway, but instead relied on Mr. Farrell's survey of the toe of the slope of the retaining walls to determine the width of the crossing.

The applicant also proposes to repair with new the existing non-conforming Title V septic system within the existing lawn to the northeast of the existing house. At its closest point the proposed septic system leach field is ~ 101 feet from the EBT, Inc delineated wetland line and the associated grading for the septic is $\sim 85'$ from the delineated line. The existing septic system shall be abandoned according to Title V requirements.

Glenn E. Krevosky of EBT Environmental Consultants, Inc. delineated the wetland boundaries in October 2020 with 4 A series, 5 '100' series, 3 B series and 2 '200 series' wetland flags - utilizing soils, vegetation and indicators of hydrology according to 310 CMR 10.55 (2) (c).

The erosion control measures of staked 9" straw wattles, for the 2023 proposed replication area and septic system work, shall be placed prior to site work. These measures shall be maintained in good working order throughout the project until all exposed soils are final graded, loamed, seeded and stabilized with well-established soil stabilizing vegetation.
