### A.6. General Project Description

Site: 446 Main Street, Sturbridge

Applicant: Dong Ying & Chin Lien Chen Ying

The applicant proposes to remove an approximately 270 square foot concrete pad, (2) concrete cylinders and (2) 4" PCV pipes from the buffer zone to the cattail marsh bordering vegetated wetland. In the Order of Conditions, dated 7/25/2002, Condition #26, these pads were required to be removed and were not. The items to be removed (pad, cylinders, and PVC pipes) will be accessed utilizing (2) 16' by 40' swamp mats to cross the water quality swale (shown on the As-Built Survey, Exhibit 1A). When the concrete pads are removed the applicant will ensure there is a minimum of 3" of organic topsoil medium to promote growth, the area will be seeded with a New England Wet Mix. The applicant also proposes to maintain the area free of beaver dams in perpetuity.

There were three perpetuity conditions listed in the 7/26/2005 Amended Order of Conditions.

- 1. Maintenance of the water quality swale In SCC's "Non-Compliance Order of Conditions" letter, dated 10/26/2022, it was stated the water quality was not constructed. The stormwater structures were completed and constructed according to the approved plan, dated 7/8/2005. The water quality swale was maintained in the fall and winter of 2022-2023 by EBT, Inc (see attached photos). The check dams, width of the swale and depth of the swale were surveyed and are identified on Levesque Geomatics "As-Built Survey" Overlay plan, dated 12/7/2022. The water quality swale will be maintained on a bi-annual basis (late spring & fall) to ensure its functionality.
- 2. Maintenance of the beaver control devices There are no beaver control devices currently at the site. The elevation of the wetland is too shallow for a efficient beaver control device (the beaver immediately clogs flow devices in shallow water settings). To ensure there are no beaver issues on the site the applicant will employ a beaver trapper on a yearly basis to remove beavers to ensure there is no flooding of the adjacent property to the east (we employed Ron Thebodo to remove once beaver at the beginning of April 2023).
- 3. Maintenance of the culverts There are no culverts at the site, as the 12" CMP was removed prior to EBT, Inc. becoming involved in the project the old CMP was not replaced by a 12" HDPE, as was proposed on the 7/8/2005 plan. The flow from the upper Cattail marsh to the lower stream channel abutting the eastern property boundary is stable with coarse rock aggregate at the surface. The daylighting of the channel allows for a natural environment for movement of wildlife along the stream corridor.

Additionally, the silt fence referenced in the Order of Conditions, dated 7/25/2002, Condition #21 was installed but was not removed - all old silt fence at the site will be fully removed (including subgrade portions). On the original plan the parking lot was not proposed to be regraded/repaved. The old pavement which existed prior to the 2002 OOC was in good condition and still is. This issue is being brought up as there was contention the site was shedding new water flow to the east.

The erosion control measures of staked 9" straw wattles, shown on the site plan, shall be placed prior to site work. These measures shall be maintained in good working order throughout the project until all exposed soils are final graded, loamed, seeded and stabilized with well-established soil stabilizing vegetation.






