#### A.6. General Project Description

Site: 698 Main Street, Fiskdale Applicant: Wrecker, LLC

The applicant is proposing to construct a 7,000 s.f. metal building with associated parking and utilities. The new building will be operated as the new "Interstate Towing" facility. The easterly portion of the site will be a paved storage yard to store equipment, impounded vehicles, and fleet vehicles. Per the Massachusetts Stormwater Handbook, the storage yard is considered a land use with higher potential pollutant loads (LUHPPL) and will utilize specific stormwater BMP's. Customer parking will be located in front of the proposed building. The existing parcel is currently undeveloped woodlands, therefore, the project is considered new development.

The undeveloped woodlands with bordering vegetated wetlands located in the central portion of the site are in the General Industrial zoning district. The property will tie in to municipal water and sewer located within the Main Street (Route 20) right-of-way.

The current site topography pitches towards the Route 20 right-of-way along the front of the site. There are currently no existing stormwater BMP's implemented on the site. A majority of the front portion of the site is within the local 200-foot jurisdictional wetland buffer.

The resource areas shown on the plans delineated by Glenn Krevosky of EBT, Inc. are agreed upon under an Order of Resource Area Delineation, DEP File #300-1133, dated 9/22/2022.

The erosion control measures of 12" staked straw wattles backed by entrenched silt fence, shown on the Site Plan, shall be placed prior to site work. These measures shall be maintained in good working order throughout the project until all exposed soils are final graded, loamed, seeded and stabilized with well-established soil stabilizing vegetation.






