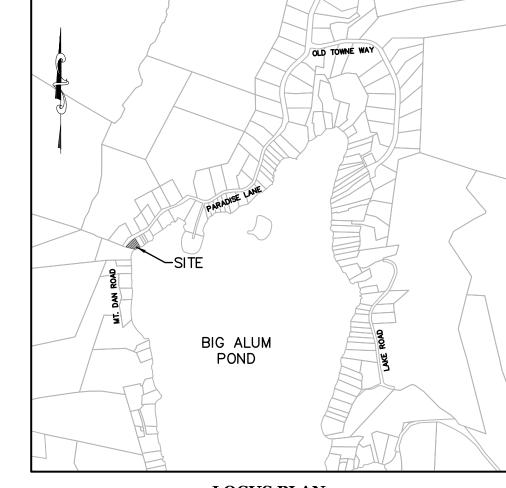

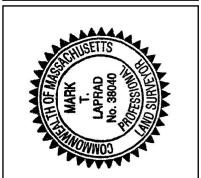

2. IF, DURING OR AFTER CONSTRUCTION, IT BECOMES APPARENT THAT EXISTING EROSION CONTROL MEASURES ARE INCAPABLE OF CONTROLLING EROSION. THE ENGINEER OR THE TOWN MAY REQUIRE ADDITIONAL CONTROL MEASURES, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO; ADDITIONAL STRAW WATTLES, STRAW BALES, SILT FENCE, SEDIMENT BASINS, MECHANICALLY ANCHORED MULCH, OR ENHANCED DEWATERING FILTRATION.

3. <u>INSPECTIONS:</u> EROSION CONTROL SHALL BE INSPECTED <u>DAILY</u> OR AFTER A LEGITIMATE STORM EVENT (0.25 INCH). INSPECTION SHALL BE RECORDED IN A LOG ALONG WITH THE TIME AND DATE. LOG SHALL BE AVAILABLE TO THE TOWN UPON REQUEST.

4. ALL TEMPORARY FILL SHALL BE STABILIZED DURING USE TO PREVENT EROSION AND SHALL BE SUITABLY CONTAINED TO PREVENT SEDIMENT OF OTHER PARTICULATE MATTER FROM REENTERING A WETLAND OR WATERCOURSE. ALL AREAS AFFECTED BY TEMPORARY FILLS MUST BE RESTORED TO THEIR ORIGINAL CONTOURS OR AS DIRECTED BY THE OWNER, AND REVEGETATED. 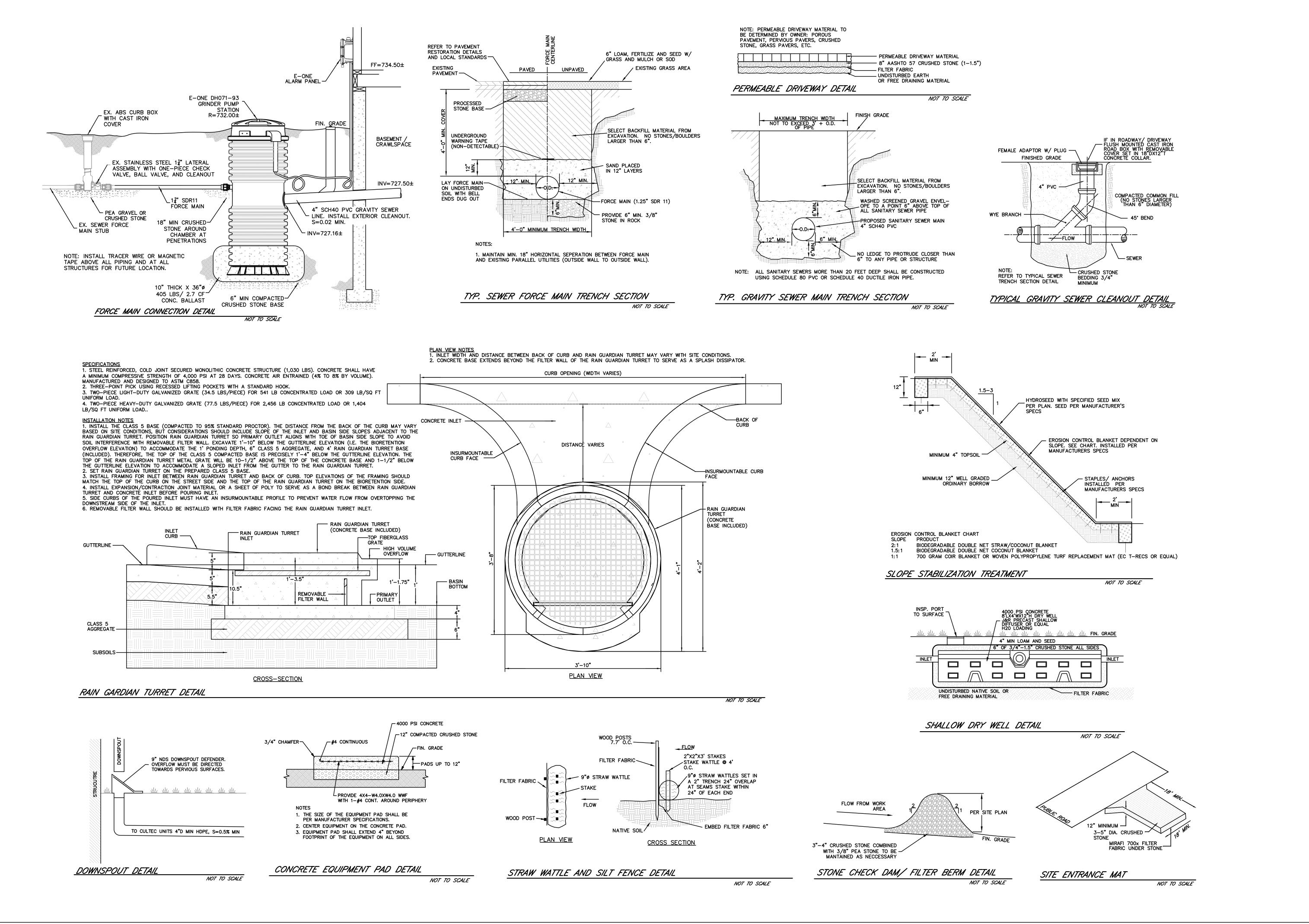
