

Proposed Project: Singular Cantilevered Dock

Project Location: 62 Mt. Dan Road on Big Alum Lake

Project Owner: Dan & Shannon St Onge

Notification: A Chapter 91 Simplified waterways license has been applied for and a Pre App number has

been assigned by the Ma. DEP, it is 23-ww-PRE-0128 APP.

Project general description:

A single cantilevered dock 32' long x 8' wide. The main structure is made of steel I beams set in a concrete counterweight, this is the primary structure that supports the dock. The counterweight will be set behind and below the existing wall. When completed, the original surface conditions will be reconstructed and the counterweight will not be seen, no trees or plants will be removed to complete the project. The boulder next to the tree stump will remain as is, the short section of stone wall attached to the boulder will be removed to allow for the steel beam installation. The top two stone steps will be removed to allow for the steel beams and counterweight. The steel beams will be set in the concrete and pass over the remaining existing stone. The deck will be constructed of composite decking. All required erosion control methods including silt fence, straw wattle and hydraulic booms will be installed and inspected before construction begins. There will be a designated location on the property which all erosion control materials will be stored in addition to the installed materials incase any are needed. Work to commence during annual lake draw down.
