


Project general description:

A single cantilevered dock 32' long x 6' wide. The main structure is made of steel I beams set in a concrete counterweight, this is the primary structure that supports the dock. The counterweight will be set behind and below the existing wall. When completed, the original surface conditions will be reconstructed and the counterweight will not be seen, no trees or plants will be removed to complete the project. The steel beams will be set in the concrete and pass through the existing stone wall in slots cut through the wall. The deck will be constructed of composite decking. All required erosion control methods including silt fence, straw wattle and hydraulic booms will be installed and inspected before construction begins. There will be a designated location on the property which all erosion control materials will be stored in addition to the installed materials incase any are needed. Work to commence during annual lake draw down.
