ACER RUBRUM

Acer Rubrum is a medium to large tree with narrow or rounded, compact crown and red flowers, fruit, leafstalks, and autumn foliage. This popular ornamental tree grows 40-60 ft. in cultivation, occasionally reaching 100 ft. in the wild. Male trees have notable pinkish red flowers in early spring, and females display decorative red samaras soon after.



GINGKGO BILOBA 'AUTUMN GOLD'

Ginkgo Biloba 'Autumn Gold' is a deciduous conifer with a broad and rounded symmetrical crown. Adding visual interest and beauty to the landscape, its spreading canopy of unique, fan-shaped leaves, turns a stunning deep yellow color in the fall.



GLEDITSIA TRIACANTHOS

Gleditsia Triacanthos typically grows 60-80' (less frequently to 120') tall with a rounded spreading crown. Trunk and branches have stout thorns (to 3" long) that are solitary or three-branched. The leaves turn bright yellow in the fall. Inconspicuous, greenish yellow to greenish white flowers appear in racemes in late spring.



QUERCUS BICOLOR

Quercus Bicolor is a medium sized, deciduous tree with a broad, rounded crown and a short trunk which typically grows at a moderate rate to a height of 50-60' (sometimes larger). Leaves are dark, shiny green above and silvery white beneath. Fall color is yellow, but sometimes reddish purple.



QUERCUS PALUSTRIS

Quercus Palustris is a straight-trunked tree with spreading to horizontal branches, very slender pinlike twigs, and a broadly conical crown. Pin oak is a strongly pyramidal tree with a distinct central leader, growing 60-70 ft. or taller. Dark-green foliage becomes dark-red in fall.



TILIA AMERICANA

Tilia Americana is a wide-spreading tree, 60-80 ft. tall, occasionally growing taller. Broadly oval leaves sometimes change to yellow in fall but often turn brown and become somewhat unsightly. This deciduous tree tends to sprout at the base, producing a clump of tall trees around what was the original tree. Flowers are inconspicuous but fragrant.



BUXUS MICROPHYLLA 'WINTER GEM'

Buxus microphylla is a dense, compact, many-branched, broad, mounded evergreen shrub with a loose and open habit. A slow grower (to 1.5" per year) which is typically grown as a 2-2.5' tall shrub with a larger spread. Apetalous, greenish yellow flowers (separate male and female flowers on the same plant) appear in spring.



ILEX GLABRA 'COMPACTA'

Ilex Glabra is a slow-growing, upright-rounded, broadleaf evergreen shrub in the holly family. Leaves usually remain attractive in winter unless temperatures dip well below zero. Greenish white flowers (male in cymes and female in cymes or single) appear in spring but are relatively inconspicuous.



JUNIPERUS CHINENSIS 'SPARTAN'

Juniperus Chinensis is a narrow, pyramidal to columnar, evergreen tree forming a handsome exclamation point in the landscape. Fast-growing, its dense and erect branches bear scale-like, dark green foliage. Ideal for providing year-round structure, perfect for hedges & windbreaks.



ROSA X 'DOUBLE KNOCKOUT'

Rosa X is a compact shrub rose which produces abundant clusters of fully double, vibrant cherry-red flowers, up to 3 in. across, packed with up to 24 petals. The blossoms do not fade in heat and stand out against the disease-resistant, dark purplish-green foliage. The foliage turns purple to burgundy in fall.



VIBURNUM DENTATUM

Viburnum dentatum is an upright, rounded, multi-stemmed, deciduous shrub which typically matures to 6-10' tall with a similar spread, but may reach a height of 15' in optimum growing conditions. Non-fragrant white flowers in flat-topped corymbs appear in late spring.



PANICUM VIRGATUM

Panicum Virgatum, or switchgrass, is generally noted for its stiff, columnar form, and typically retains its vertical shape throughout the growing season. It is a clump-forming, warm season grass which typically grows to 3' tall. Features medium green leaves which turn yellow (sometimes with orange tints) in autumn, fading to tan-beige in winter.
