Ch. 40A, §11, the Planning Board will hold a Public Hearing on **Tuesday, June 27, 2023 at 6:35 PM** in the **Center Office Building located at 301 Main Street, Sturbridge, MA 01566 and/or by virtual means** if circumstances warrant, in accordance with applicable law; on the application of the ICON Architecture representing the Town of Sturbridge for the property location is 480 Main Street.

The applicant requests Site Plan Approval as required by the Sturbridge Zoning Bylaw Article XIX, Site Plan Review to allow the renovation of and the construction of an addition to the Senior Center and related site improvements at 480 Main Street, Sturbridge as shown on the plans and materials submitted.

Additionally, the applicant is requesting a Special Permit as required by the Sturbridge Zoning Bylaw Chapter 300, Article V Groundwater Protection District to allow a use that will render more than 15% or 2,500 square feet of the lot impervious, whichever is greater. The project as designed results in .92 acres of impervious area.
