A.6. General Project Description

Site: 60 Farquhar Road, Sturbridge

Applicant: Craig Bernier

The applicant proposes to remove 3 White Pines within the outer riparian zone. The removal of the three trees will amount to 235 square feet of alteration within the riverfront area. The area where the trees have been removed will be reverted to lawn. The area where the trees are to be removed is surrounded by existing asphalt driveway.

The site falls within the NHESP priority & estimated habitat polygons but the work is exempt per 321 CMR 10.14 (5) (below).

321 CMR 10.14 (5): construction or removal of structures that are secondary to the primary residence and located within existing paved areas and lawfully developed and maintained lawns or landscaped areas on residential properties, provided there is no expansion of such existing paved, lawn and landscaped areas;

Glenn E. Krevosky of EBT Environmental Consultants, Inc. delineated the wetland boundaries on 3/19/2023 with 12 A series wetland flags - utilizing soils, vegetation and indicators of hydrology according to 310 CMR 10.55 (2) (c). The mean annual high water was flagged with one "MAHW" flag at the closest point to the proposed garage.

The erosion control measures of staked 9" straw wattles backed by entrenched silt fence, shown on the site plan, shall be placed prior to site work. These measures shall be maintained in good working order throughout the project until all exposed soils are final graded, loamed, seeded and stabilized with well-established soil stabilizing vegetation.

GENERAL PROJECT DESCRIPTION FOR WORK SUBJECT TO STURBRIDGE WETLAND BYLAW

Site: 60 Farquhar Road, Sturbridge

Applicant: Craig Bernier

The applicant proposes to construct a 60' by 35' proposed garage within the 200-foot buffer zone to a bordering vegetated wetland. A stockpile location has been designated outside of all buffer zones.

The applicant proposes to remove 3 White Pines within the outer riparian zone. The removal of the three trees will amount to ± 235 square feet of alteration within the riverfront area (stump removal). The large pines stick up individually (no other trees are adjacent to buffer wind) and sway in the wind. During heavy gusts the concern is they will snap and hit the proposed structure. The area where the trees have been removed will be reverted to lawn. The area where two of the trees are to be removed is surrounded by an existing asphalt driveway.

The site falls within the NHESP priority & estimated habitat polygons but the work is exempt per 321 CMR 10.14 (5) (below).

321 CMR 10.14 (5): construction or removal of structures that are secondary to the primary residence and located within existing paved areas and lawfully developed and maintained lawns or landscaped areas on residential properties, provided there is no expansion of such existing paved, lawn and landscaped areas;

Krevosky of EBT Environmental Consultants, Inc. delineated the wetland boundaries on 3/19/2023 with 12 A series wetland flags - utilizing soils, vegetation and indicators of hydrology according to 310 CMR 10.55 (2) (c). The mean annual high water was flagged with one "MAHW" flag at the closest point to the proposed garage.

The erosion control measures of staked 9" straw wattles backed by entrenched silt fence, shown on the site plan, shall be placed prior to site work. These measures shall be maintained in good working order throughout the project until all exposed soils are final graded, loamed, seeded and stabilized with well-established soil stabilizing vegetation.




