REMOVAL OF 36 TREES DAMAGED, INJURED, DYING, DEAD DUE TO GYPSY MOTH, WOOLY DISEASE AND POTENTIAL HAZARD OF PROXIMETRY TO HOME, SHED AND POWER LINES. SEE ATTACHED PICTURES WITH DESCRIPTION. SEVEN ARE DEAD OF WHICH TWO ARE TOPS OF TREES BROKEN OFF AND WILL REMAIN ON GROUND AFTER CUTTING. HEMLOCKS HAVE WOOLY DISEASE, ONE HAS ALREADY FALLEN. OTHERS HIT BY GYPSY MOUTH TWO YEARS IN A ROW AND NOT RECOVERED, CLOSE TO HOUSE, POWER LINES AND SHED.

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

If you're looking at the house from the street.


Front right side – 2 oak trees, 1 Hemlock Oaks are close to the house, Hemlock has Wolly disease.

Front center 4 oak trees these trees are close or leaning towards the house and power line






Left side -6A(dead), 7, 7A(dead), 8, 9, 9A(not pictured). The trees on this side have been hit hard by the gypsy moths, close to power lines and the house, some are dead and others losing limbs.



Left side – 10, 11, 12, 13 oak trees, hit hard by the gypsy moths, #10 is close to the house and limbs have fallen from it on to the roof, downed Hemlock (14) in the back needs limbing, cut and removal. It's currently off the ground and is potential hazard.









At back of yard 15, limbs keep falling off, has moth damage.

Trees way back in the yard. 16, 17, 18. 16 is dead and infested, 17 & 18 are tops of trees that broken off and are leaning, all these should be laid down on the ground so they are not a hazard.



Trees by the wood pile 19, 20, 21, 22, 23. Hemlocks hit by Woolly disease. Picture on left is facing them from the yard, the right one is from the front of the house. They are very bare and have lost almost all needles. The others have damage from trees falling on them from the neighbors. I'd like to replant this area with a maple?







Trees 24, 25, 26, 27. Hemlocks hit hard by Woolly disease. #27 is dead and infested with ants. These are also very close to the house.



Trees 28, 29, 30. Hemlock with Woolly disease, Oak is leaning toward the shed. Would like to replant here.





Trees 31, 32 are going up from the shed towards the street and to the left from trees 1&2. The Hemlock has Woolly disease and has lost many limbs, the oak is close to the house.
