Trail Counter Data:

• In May:

 There were 7,088 total trail visitors based on Trafx counter data. This is an increase of 581 visitors as compared to last month. This data includes traffic from Leadmine, Riverlands, Heins Farm, Plimpton, and Long Pond trail heads.

 The most visited property was Leadmine (Shattuck, Morgan, Pinelands) with 5,119 visitors, followed by Riverlands with 786 visitors, Heins Farm with 785 visitors, Long Pond with 244 visitors, and Plimpton with 154 visitors.
